



## CIM went active

The CIM project just reached one of its key milestones in terms of project goals: the CIM workshop. A five-day training took place in Palermo that enabled trainers and teachers to understand and apply the CIM approach – the creative and innovative blended learning program.

Based on a self-awareness process, the partnership and its trainers went through the development of learning projects, supported by the Design Thinking approach.

For five days, they tested, readjusted, validated, and refined how to foster creativity and innovation. By going through the various design thinking steps and using methods such as brainwriting, participants were able to break through linear thought processes and think creatively instead, and great new ideas emerged in a short period of time. At the end of the week, each group presented their developed idea to the other groups in a final presentation.

We look back on a successful week with many new ideas, interesting discussions and new insights and would like to thank all participants for their participation and enthusiasm.
